### Summer Food Program Assistant(s) – Food Prep and Distribution

The Door County YMCA has various opportunities for energetic professionals to make a difference in our community. This position requires a commitment to the YMCA's mission and work as a cause-driven, community organization. The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) was established to ensure that children continue to receive nutritious meals when school is not in session. Free meals, that meet Federal nutrition guidelines, are provided to all children 18 years old and under at approved sites within the Sturgeon Bay community. The Summer Food Program Assistants are responsible for preparation, delivery, and/or distribution of meals under the SFSP program.

## KEY QUALIFICATIONS

Summer Foods Assistants are responsible for preparing, serving, delivering, cleaning up, and storing of food for the YMCA Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), and may involve collaborative. The Assistant must provide a clean and healthy working environment; licensing and food service regulations, as set by the State of Wisconsin, must be strictly adhered to at all times. The Summer Food Program Assistant position(s) require high energy, strong organization skills and knowledge of proper food handling, preparation, storage and cleaning aids. Assistant must be able to work efficiently and effectively in tight spaces and under timeline pressures, making quick decisions and carrying out detailed instruction. Relationship building skills and collaborative spirit are key elements for success

## DETAILS

The Summer Food Assistant(s) position would be based off-site at the location of our collaborating partner, Door County Boys & Girls Club. Positions may involve travel and coordination among our various food service sites within and around Door County. Pay range will be \$9-11/hour, depending on experience and position. Schedule and hours are based around the early morning and mid-afternoon timeframes. Free YMCA membership is included. Applicants must be at least 18 years old.
